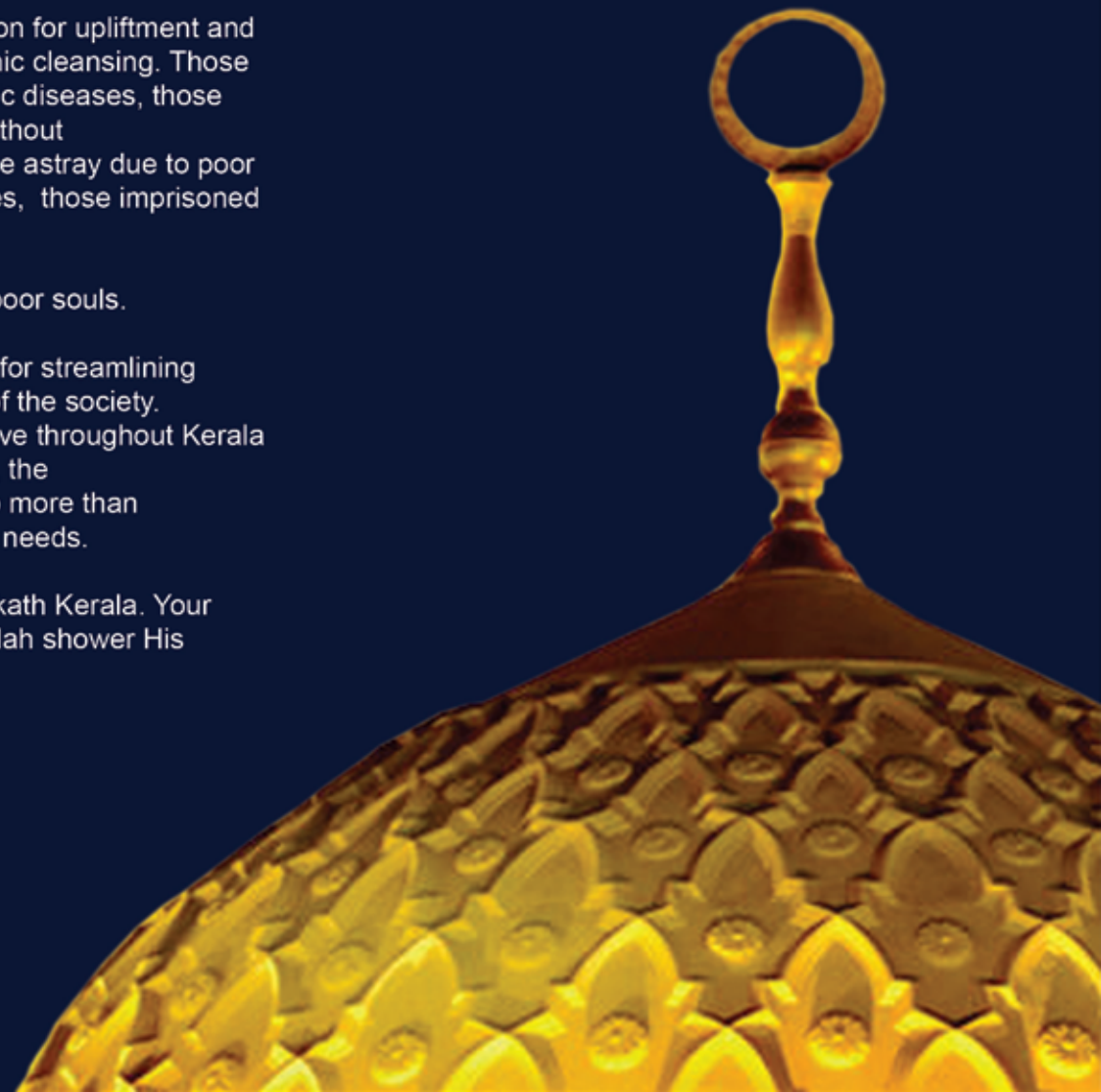
Proper utilization of Zakath helps in wiping tears of these poor souls.

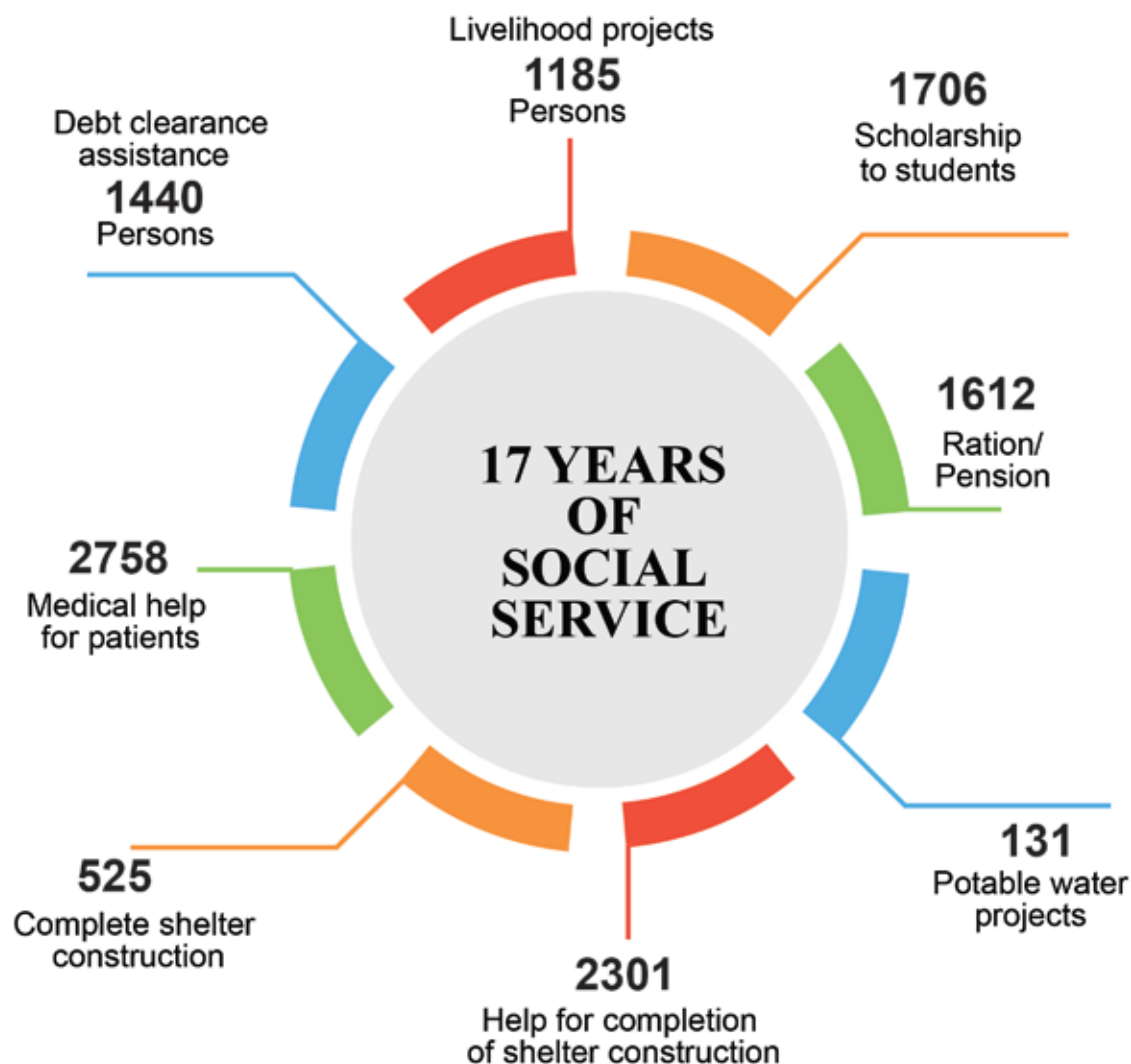

ZAKATH ADMINISTRATION

- Zakath donors belonging to Malayalee community every year entrusts their zakath directly to Baithuzzakath Kerala or credit into bank account.
- The deserving zakath beneficiaries can directly apply for the projects or schemes through online on www.baithuzzakathkerala.org
- Applicants as well as area and regional zakath coordinators can check status as well as follow up through the website or SMS.
- The Area Coordinators of Baithuzzakath Kerala makes field visits for the applications received online and submits report. In Kerala, 142 Area Coordinators and 14 District coordinators render service for Baithuzzakath.
- Based on the interviews and suggestions of regional zakath units and the report submitted by Coordinators, deserving beneficiaries are selected.
- Collaborative projects with the cooperation of regional zakath/relief projects and beneficiaries.
- The zakath amount is directly transferred to the accounts of selected beneficiaries. For larger projects, the amount is released in stages after due follow up of progress of the project.
- Proper system in place to scrutinize and follow up of every project to ensure proper utilization of fund sanctioned.
- Training programmes for regional zakath enterprises, annual audit, survey and analytical reports by Baithuzzakath Kerala.

CALCULATE YOUR ZAKATH

Items Eligible for Zakat	Eligible Period	Nisab
Gold, Pearl, precious stones etc.	Equivalent of 85 grams of gold or precious stones	2.5%
Silver	595 gms	2.5%
Paddy, Coconut, Arecanut	Annually, after deducting the cost of cultivation and harvest, if 1300 kg of paddy or its equivalent of coconut and arecanut	10%
	If the cost not deducted	5%
Rubber, Cashew, Black pepper, tea leaves	Annually approx income equivalent to 1300 kg of paddy	10%
	If the cost not deducted	5%
	If considered as money crop, then 2.5% - emphasis on first case.	
Tapioca, Potato, elephant foot, banana, beans, mango, jackfruit, papaya	Annually, if the income is approximately the rate of 650 kgs of rice.	10%
Rented house, industry, goat farm, poultry farm, travel agency, bus, jeep, autorickshaw, hospital, school etc.	After deducting the running cost, salary and depreciation, if the annual income is equivalent to approximately 650 kgs of rice	10%
All agricultural produces combined	Another opinion – 2.5% has to paid if the income is equivalent to 85 gms of gold	10%
Business	If each produce reaches the limit of zakath and if the income of different produce is equivalent to 650 kgs of rice After deducting all expenditure in running the business and taxes, if the profit plus	2.5%

Items Eligible for Zakat	Eligible Period	Nisab
Salary, wages, Doctor Fees, Supervision Fee of engineers, consultancy fee, commission etc.	After deducting basic needs and expenses, if the income is equivalent to 85 gms of gold	2.5%
Fish	If commodity for sale	2.5%
	After deducting the cost of fishing	10%
	Without deducting the cost of fishing	5%
Bonus, Retirement Benefits, Gratuity etc.	If the amount is equivalent to 85 gms of gold	2.5%
Share (Trading)	If the businessman is not paying zakath, the amount of share and profit is equivalent to 85 gms of gold	2.5%
Share (Industry, School, Rented building, hospital etc.)	If the annual income is equivalent to 650 kgs of rice	10%
Real estate	If the annual profit plus the price of unsold land in possession is equivalent to 85 gms of gold	2.5%
Treasure, stone, sand etc..	After deducting the cost and wages, on the income	20%
Total Income	If the income from agriculture, business doesn't reach the limit of zakat, and if the total income from salary and other incomes is equivalent to 85 gms of gold	2.5%
